Overview

Rosemary Oil is obtained from the Rosmarinus officinalis, a medium-sized, bushy evergreen shrub that can grow to around 2.5 metres tall and 2.5 metres wide. Growing wild in the Atlas Mountains at an altitude of between 800 and 2000 metres, with the oil being produced from the shrub's aerial parts.

The plant thrives in a sunny, partially shaded environment with moist but well-drained soil. Once the Rosemary shrub is fully mature and well-established, it can be harvested from June - September. However, it can take up to 15 months of hard work and dedication before the plant is large enough to be harvested.
