

Lemongrass Oil

Overview

Lemongrass is considered native to India, belonging to the Cymbopogon genus although there are a number of commercial Lemongrass Oils available today throughout Asia of differing Cymbopogon species.

A fast growing tropical grass that can grow to around 2 metres tall, the green leaves / grass are long, rigid and erect. The oil containing aerial parts are harvested between June to December, the plant is cut down to around 0.5 metres above ground level and a number of cuts can be made during the harvest period.
